

Skatetown Guest Coach Protocol

Allowances for guest coaches apply primarily to local competition weeks and/or CCFSC test sessions. Guest coaching privileges will be extended for a maximum of 2 days per calendar month. However, some exceptions and special circumstances may be granted by the Skatetown Skating Director(s). Skatetown reserves the right to approve or deny any guest coach who seeks the opportunity to coach/instruct at Skatetown.

Any coach not affiliated with the Skatetown Skating Department, seeking the opportunity to guest coach/instruct at Skatetown must contact the Skating Director (916)783-8550 extension113 at least seven (7) days in advance. They will need to provide the skating director with a valid, current proof of liability insurance certificate.

Upon approval and prior to their first ice session, a guest coach must stop by Skatetown front desk, submit a current copy of their liability insurance certificate and pay the required applicable pro fee.

The guest coach fees are as follows:

- 1st freestyle session that the guest coach uses= pro fee is \$25.00
- 2nd freestyle session that the guest coach uses = pro fee is an additional \$15.00 (\$40 for 2 freestyle sessions)
- Coaching on 3 or more freestyle sessions will be a maximum pro fee of \$50.00 per day
- Only freestyles after 9:30am on weekdays and any freestyle sessions on Saturday may be used for guest coaching.

Any coach in violation of not paying the above required pro fees will have guest coaching privileges permanently denied.

After the pro fee is paid, the guest coach will receive a “guest coach pass” to be kept available as proof they are compliant with all guest coach policies. Once at Skatetown, the guest coach agrees to follow all Skatetown freestyle rules and regulations. All coaches must adhere to the PSA Code of Ethics. Soliciting in any form is strictly prohibited. Failure to comply will result in the loss of guest coach privileges.

Please note that all guest skaters must pay their own freestyle costs.

**The guest coach protocol does not apply to coaches who are invited by the Skating Director to work special skating camps or other special appearances.*
