Adult Hockey League

Skatetown's adult hockey league season will consist of 20 games (2 pre-season, 16 regular season, and 2 playoff games.) Championship games to be held in August—dates and times to be announced. All players must be at least 18 years of age.

All levels are non-checking with Skatetown and USA Hockey Rules being strictly enforced.

Divisions:

- ◆ Bronze—Novice
- ◆ Silver B—Novice+ thru Intermediate
- ◆ Silver A—Intermediate
- ◆ Gold B—Intermediate+ thru Advanced
- ◆ Gold A—Advanced



New Players: Players looking for teams will be placed on a "Free Agent" list and will be contacted by individual team captains who are looking for players. Players looking to join a league may contact the Hockey Director, at (916) 783-8550 x 114 or e-mail hockey@skatetown.biz.

Game Format: 3 - 15-minute stop-time periods (game length limited to 1 hour 15 minutes). Tied games in result in a three-man shoot out. During playoffs, a five-minute overtime will be played five on five, then go to a three-man shootout.

Team fees: Team fees are \$7050. A team must have the team fee paid by March 20th, 2011. If fees are not satisfied by this date, the team will default to an individual per player fee. Captains will need to turn in complete packets including full payment, by 3/20/2011 to Hockey Director or designated staff.

Team fee payment plan option: Teams will have the option of putting 2/3 payment (\$4700) down and paying the remaining 1/3 payment (\$2350) half way through the season. Final payment must be exact and made in one single transaction.

Individual fees: Individual fees are \$470. Registration will open on March 21, 2011. Individuals paying in full can register online at skatetown.biz. There is no pro-rating of league fees except for brand new players to the league.

Individual fee payment plan option: A \$20 handling fee is added to the individual fee. To qualify for this payment plan, player agrees to play the entire season and pay the entire league fee. A credit card, with valid expiration date and the cardholder's signature authorizing Skatetown to charge the account for the payments when due is required. If payment is not current, player will not be allowed to participate in the league until fees are satisfied. No cash or check payments allowed. For all late payments or declined credit cards, a \$25 admin fee will be applied to individual payments.

\$490 total cost:

\$230 down + \$20 fee: \$80 due 5/1/11; \$80 due 6/1/11; \$80 due 7/1/11.

Rosters: Teams paying a team fee can roster up to 18 skaters and a goalie. Only 15 players are permitted on the bench for any game. Teams paying a per player fee may have a maximum of 15 players plus a goalie. League management may place players on teams that pay on an individual basis until maximum number players is achieved. Rosters must be submitted on March 27th, 2011. Players on roster must be registered and paid to appear on the score sheet. Rosters will be frozen after the 12th week on June 19, 2011.
