# APPROACH

Skatetown's youth hockey league is a recreational program with an emphasis on having fun and learning the game of ice hockey. The Spring/Summer 2010 season consists of 20 games and 20 practices. A mandatory parent orientation will take place at the beginning of the season during the first practice

**Dates:** League dates April 4 – August 21. The first practices will be held as follows:

Mites: 4/8 at 5pm

Squirts: 4/4 at 5pm

High school 4/4 at 7pm



**Divisions:** There are 3 divisions. Player's age at the beginning of the season is where he/she should register.

**ALL DIVISIONS ARE NON-CHECKING**

- Mite (8 and under)
- Squirt/PeeWee (9-12 years of age)
- High School (13 -17)

**Parity:** Players may be moved throughout the season to ensure continued parity. Travel players must be approved by hockey director prior to registration.

**Youth League fees:**

- Mites \$780
- Squirt/PeeWee \$780
- High School \$780

**Payment Plan Option:** A \$20 handling fee is added to the fee. To qualify for this payment plan, player agrees to play the entire season and pay the entire league fee. A credit card, with valid expiration date and the cardholder's signature authorizing Skatetown to charge the account for the payments when due, is required. If payment is not current, player will not be allowed to participate in the league until fees are satisfied. No cash or check payments allowed. If credit card is declined, there will be a \$25 admin fee added to the individual fee payment. All pro-rated sign ups must be made at the front counter. Players may pro-rate into the season, anytime until the last three weeks. Pro-rated fees are not eligible with the payment plan option.

**Format:** Mite level will be played cross-ice with no score kept. Skatetown coaches referee and oversee play. The rink will be divided up with "Border Patrol" pads into sections.

Squirt/PeeWee & High School level games will be played on full ice with referees and scorekeepers. Game times are one hour.

Practices will be team practices with teams sharing the ice. Practice days may change depending on registration levels.

**Equipment Requirements:** Full equipment is required including HECC approved helmet with full shield or cage, mouth guard, shoulder, shin & elbow pads, hockey pants with padding and hockey gloves.

**Jerseys:** Cost of team jerseys is not included in the league fees. Skatetown jerseys, in the appropriate league color must be worn by all players and can be purchased from the Skatetown Pro Shop. Both jerseys must have matching numbers for accurate stats.
