Youth Learn to Play Hockey

Skatetown's Youth Learn To Play Hockey Program is based on the USA Hockey Initiation Program, which is designed to teach basic hockey skills while at the same time creating a fun environment.

Since students progress at different rates, sessions are often repeated in order to learn all the skills needed to become a good hockey player. Attending stick time sessions, skills & drills classes, taking private lessons and attending public skating sessions will help a player improve their skills. Due to the weekly curriculum, *Hockey 1 class cannot be pro-rated after the first week without approval.*

All classes will be conducted in a cross ice format using 1/4, 1/3 or 1/2 of the ice. Classes of less than 5 students may be cancelled or combined with another class.

Beginner skaters can enroll in Parent & Me (ages 7 and younger), Hockey 1 (recommended for ages 7 or older) or one of our 4-week introductory hockey classes. Skaters can also enroll in an 8-week or 13-week Pre-Alpha class through our Learn to Skate program to work on basic skills including forward and backward skating and snowplow stops. Class Descriptions

Parent/Child Hockey 1*: This class follows the Hockey 1 curriculum, but is set up for a parent to be on the ice with their child. This is a great way to introduce kids to structured hockey classes. Children are welcome to attend this class by themselves. Players ages 8 and younger have the option of going directly to the Mites House League after passing Parent & Me/Hockey 1. Please wear figure skates unless you can skate unassisted in hockey skates.

Hockey 1*: This class is geared for new players or for those who have not had formal lessons. Players ages 8 and younger have the option of going directly to the Mites House League after passing Hockey 1. Please wear figure skates unless you can skate unassisted in hockey skates.

Parent Orientation: Orientations will be held at 7pm on the Wednesday night prior to the first class for Parent & Me and Hockey 1 Parents and students. Kids skate the public session free while parents attend the orientation. Loaner equipment is handed out at this time. **You must attend this orientation to check out loaner gear packages.**

Hockey 2: This program is geared for the player who has passed Hockey 1 or has comparable skills.

Hockey 3: This program is geared for the player who has passed Hockey 2 or has comparable skills.

Hockey 4: This program is geared for the player who has passed Hockey 3 or has comparable skills.

Class format/length: Learn to Play Hockey semesters are 13 weeks in duration and last one hour and 15 minutes. The first hour includes structured curriculum and games. The final 15 minutes is pond hockey fun time.

Cost: The \$195 fee is payable upon registration. A split payment plan is also available and will include a \$5 handling fee plus \$95 due at enrollment and \$100 due **March 18th & June 17th**. New hockey program enrollees also receive a Skatetown jersey at the parent orientation. All pro-rated sign ups must be made at the front counter. No cash or check payments allowed with payment plan. If credit card is declined, there will be a \$25 admin fee added to the program fee payment.

Students receive: Skatetown Hockey jersey, voucher booklet with one free skate rental voucher for each class, a coupon for 10% discount off hockey skates, and three two-for-one skating passes to any public skating session. All passes expire the last day of classes.

Missed Classes: Make-up classes will not be permitted. Please make every effort to attend class on your designated day and time.

Equipment Requirements: HECC-approved helmets are required for **all** hockey programs. Use of skates, sticks and helmets are included in the Learn to Play Hockey class fee. Each student must provide their own gloves.

Parent & Me/Hockey 1— All gear required for Hockey 1 and Parent & Me can be checked out for the semester at no cost. A valid credit card number is required for loaner gear. Equipment is handed out at the parent orientation prior to start of class. Parent must accompany child for all 13 weeks.



Full equipment is required for Hockey 2, 3 & 4 classes. Full equipment includes helmet, elbow pads, shin/knee guards, hockey pants, shoulder pads and gloves. Beginner equipment packages are available in Skatetown's Pro-Shop. Full equipment is recommended for parents attending Parent & Me classes. Parents are required to wear HECC approved hockey helmets and hockey skates.
