

How to Proceed With Home School Skating Options (continued)

Private Lessons w/a Skatetown Instructor

Obtain a Purchase Order or Voucher from your homeschool teacher in the amount of Private Lessons the skater will take for a calendar month. *All Private Lessons must be paid in advance.* When the Skating Department receives funds from your home school your Skatetown House Account will be credited for the amount of the check received. All Purchase Orders and Vouchers for Private Lessons must be submitted to the Skating Department.

Private Lessons w/Contracted Skatetown Instructor

Obtain a Purchase Order or Voucher from your home school teacher to cover the amount of Private Lessons the skater will take for a calendar month. It will be up to your Instructor to arrange payment for the student's lesson. All Purchase Orders or Vouchers must be submitted to the Skating Department.

There will be no refunds on home school funds
Funds to be used for skating activities only

Important FAQs



- Purchase Orders & Vouchers are NOT checks
- Skatetown will not receive funds from your home school until the skater has completed the class, lesson, or session listed on your Purchase Order or Voucher
- The Skating Department submits monthly invoices for each skater in home school, however, we do not always receive payment
- Your home school allows a calculated percentage of funds to be allocated to physical education. Consult with your home school for the allowable percentage
- Not all calendar months are a home school options at Skatetown. Please consult your individual home school program.

Home School Group Skate Options

Group Skate Field trips, summer cool-downs or whatever the occasion, Skatetown is a great place to have fun. For students who are new to skating, we offer buckets that give skaters the balance and confidence needed for an enjoyable experience. \$7 per person weekdays, \$8 per person weekends. Minimum of 15 skaters. Skate rental is included.

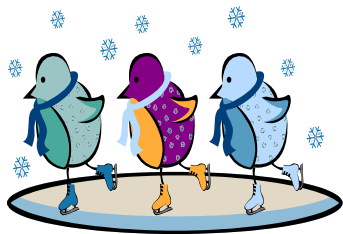

Home School Skating Options:

- Learn to Skate Group Classes
- Public Sessions
- Freestyle Sessions
- Private Lessons

Learn to Skate Classes

4-week: \$50

8-week: \$120

13-week: \$195

Included in the \$195 fee are the following:

- One 30 minute class each week for 13 weeks
- 13 FREE Public Session passes that include skate rental for Alpha level and below
- 2 FREE Guest Skating passes to use at any public session
- Ribbons and badges to mark your accomplishments
- An opportunity to perform in shows, recitals, and competitions

Public Sessions

Public Sessions are offered daily at various times. These are ice skating sessions that are open to the public. Please see our Public Session flyer or website for times.

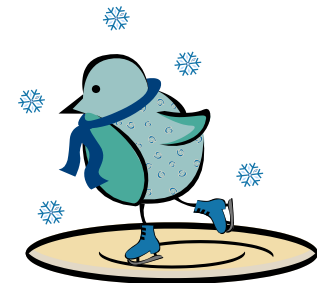
Freestyle Sessions

These sessions are primarily for the more competitive figure skater. All sessions are one hour unless otherwise noted and are offered throughout the day. If you are unsure if a freestyle session is for you, consult your instructor.

Private Lessons

Private instruction is available from Skatetown's professional staff. Lesson length typically varies from 15-60 minutes. Lessons may be scheduled on Public or Freestyle Sessions. The instructor will provide guidance as to which session is most suitable for your needs. If you are interested in Private Lessons you must complete a Private Lesson Request Form and submit it to the Skating Department; an instructor will be assigned to you. Lesson costs vary and do not include the arena's admission or skate rental fees.

How to Proceed With Home School Skating Options:



Learn to Skate Group Classes Obtain a Purchase Order or Voucher from your homeschool teacher for the full amount of the Learn to Skate Group Class in which you are enrolling the student. Complete a Registration Form and submit it with your Purchase Order or Voucher to a Skatetown Cashier. Purchase Orders and Vouchers can be faxed to our Skating Department; please see Homeschool Contacts section. If your Purchase Order or Voucher is not for the full amount of your Group Class, you will be responsible for the balance due at the time of registration. Online registration is not available for homeschool skaters.

Public & Freestyle Sessions Obtain a Purchase Order or Voucher from your homeschool teacher in the amount of Public and/or Freestyle Sessions you would like the student to skate during a calendar month. You will be required to pay for the Public and/or Freestyle Session on the day the student skates, once we receive funds from your homeschool we will credit your Skatetown House Account for the amount of the check. Be sure your Purchase Order or Voucher for Public Sessions includes skate rental if applicable. All Purchase Orders and Vouchers for Public & Freestyle Sessions must be submitted to the Skating Department.
